This is a request for **Open Market Pricing**.

The U.S. District Court, District of Hawaii (Court) is requesting quotations for either a 10-months or a month-to-month parking agreement. Please quote the charge per parking space on a monthly basis.

COVERAGE PERIOD: November 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Self-Parking stalls for approximately 30 vehicles. The number of parking stalls needed may vary from month-to-month, depending on need. The Court does not guarantee a minimum number of stalls each month;
2. Parking is available Monday through Friday, with in and out privileges during the day;
3. At the beginning of each month, your Company will receive 1/2 of the monthly rate from the Court's employees, and the other 1/2 from the Court. The Court requires monthly invoices to be provided by your Company to pay for the Court's 1/2 of the monthly rate. The preferred method of payment is credit card;
4. The Court has a few employees who are not eligible to have 1/2 of their parking fees paid by the Court. The Court would like these employees to have parking at the same monthly rate as the rest of the employees. These employees will be responsible for paying the entire monthly rate at the beginning of each month;
5. The parking lot shall be within a 0.5 mile perimeter of the U.S. District Court. The Court's address is stated below (delivery address);
6. If a month-to-month agreement is entered, the Court requires at least a 60 day notice before ending the agreement to give the Court time to enter into an agreement with another company.
