**SECOND ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE IN  
"ORDER REGARDING RETROACTIVE APPLICATION  
OF SENTENCING GUIDELINE AMENDMENTS"**

On October 21, 2014, the district judges of this court issued their Order Regarding Retroactive Application of Sentencing Guideline Amendments. The Order set forth procedures applicable to Defendants who may be eligible for relief pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) given the retroactive effect of Amendment 782 to the United States Sentencing Guidelines. The Order provided in part for the Federal Public Defender, no later than February 2, 2015, to submit a motion for relief or stipulation to reduce sentence to the court for each Defendant eligible for relief, or to seek an extension of that deadline before that date or to schedule a status conference with the duty Magistrate Judge to address scheduling for particular Defendants. On January 23, 2015, the district judges extended the February 2 deadline to May 4, 2015. The court has been informed that the May 4 deadline cannot be met with respect to a number of Defendants. The court accordingly extends that deadline to **November 4, 2015.**

If there are numerous Defendants who may be eligible for relief with respect to whom a motion for relief or stipulation to reduce sentence cannot be submitted to the court by **November 4, 2015**, the Federal Public Defender shall seek, before **November 4, 2015**, an extension of time from the active district judges, who may together extend that deadline for a reasonable period. Alternatively, before **November 4, 2015**, the Federal Public Defender may seek an extension of time from individual sentencing judges if practicable, or schedule status conferences with the duty Magistrate Judge to address scheduling for particular Defendants.
