Dear Program Administrator:

The United States Pretrial Services Office for the District of Hawaii is soliciting proposals to provide treatment services for male and female federal clients who are in need of outpatient medication assisted treatment on the Island of Oahu.

These individuals include persons under the supervision of the United States Pretrial Services as well as persons under the supervision of the United States Probation Office, who are on probation, supervised release, or parole. This group could also include inmates in the United States Bureau of Prisons who are residing in federal or contract community treatment centers.

The Request For Proposal (RFP) contains the full text of all applicable Government regulations, and all offerors are subject to the provisions contained in the RFP. In responding to the RFP, you should answer fully each item and supply all information requested. Section "L" provides specific directions for potential vendors in completing their proposals. The minimum standards for services listed are contained in the Clauses and Terms of Agreements, and all proposals will be evaluated by the criteria identified in Section "M."

Proposals will be awarded on the basis of initial offers submitted, and each initial offer should contain your organization's best terms from a price and technical standpoint. There will be no additional opportunity to modify your proposal.

Please read the RFP carefully; do not rely on knowledge of previous RFPs, or knowledge of previous federal procurement procedures.

The estimated monthly quantity (EMQ) listed in Section "B" of the RFP is the estimate of the services to be provided during the term of this agreement. It is only an estimate.

Although the Government may choose to enter into a Blanket Purchase Agreement with multiple vendors, the Government reserves the right to award to a single vendor.

The term for this Blanket Purchase Agreement is twelve (12) months, with a provision that shall allow the Government to unilaterally extend the agreement for an additional two (2) years, at the Government's discretion.

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A vendor must be capable of providing all services identified in Section "B" and within the geographic area identified in Section "B."

For all proposals, an original and two (2) copies must be received no later than **4:00 p.m. on August 28, 2019**, at 300 Ala Moana Blvd., Room 2100, Honolulu, Hawaii 96850. **Please do not resubmit a blank copy of the RFP with the proposal.**

All copies must be originally signed. A copy of the Blanket Purchase Agreement, Clauses and Terms of Agreement, should be retained by the vendor for their files. **Please do not submit proposals in binders or notebooks or with tabs.**

Please note that federal clients are to receive priority placement in the treatment programs and a contractor's ability to discharge a federal client without the involvement of the Pretrial Services or Probation Officer is limited.
