**AUGUST 11, 2020 TEMPORARY GENERAL ORDER SUSPENDING
GRAND JURIES IN THE DISTRICT OF HAWAII IN RESPONSE TO
COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

Given the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and public health emergency, including the dramatic rise in COVID-19 cases in the State of Hawaii over the previous weeks, and the continued need to protect grand jurors, court employees, and witnesses from being exposed to the COVID-19 virus, and with the agreement of all of the judges of the United States District Court for the District of Hawaii, this Temporary General Order supersedes the Court's May 29, 2020 Temporary General Order Resuming Grand Jury Sessions in the District of Hawaii During the COVID-10 Emergency. The Court orders as follows:

All grand jury proceedings in the District of Hawaii are suspended until further notice by the Court.
