GRAND JURY TO SIT THROUGH JUNE 2021**

Given the state of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, including the continued need to protect grand jurors, court employees, and witnesses from being exposed to the COVID-19 virus, and considering the need for federal grand juries to continue to meet, the court authorizes up to three grand jury sessions to be held per month through the end of June 2021, with appropriate mitigation measures in place.
