**GENERAL ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS FOR ATTORNEY'S
FEES AND RELATED NONTAXABLE EXPENSES**

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(d)(2)(B), relating to the timing and contents of a motion for attorney's fees and related nontaxable expenses, states:

(B) *Timing and Contents of the Motion.* Unless a statute or a court order provides otherwise, the motion must:

- (i) be filed no later than 14 days after the entry of judgment;
- (ii) specify the judgment and the statute, rule, or other grounds entitling the movant to the award;
- (iii) state the amount sought or provide a fair estimate of it; and
- (iv) disclose, if the court so orders, the terms of any agreement about fees for the services for which the claim is made.

Effective as of the date of this Order, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the timing and content of motions seeking an award of attorney's fees and related nontaxable expenses pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(d)(2) shall be governed by

United States District Court for the District of Hawaii Local Rule 54.2 and not
Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(d)(2)(B).
