Mentorship Program Participants may serve for a term of up to **three (3) years** unless otherwise permitted by the CJA Panel Committee. Mentorship Program Participants will work closely with and under the guidance of experienced CJA Panel Attorneys selected by the CJA Panel Committee to serve as mentors. Upon demonstrating proficiency in federal criminal practice, participants may be considered by the CJA Panel Committee, with the Court's approval, to serve as CJA Panel Attorneys. Mentors and participants will be compensated.

CJA Panel Attorneys and Mentorship Program Participants shall be registered ECF Users in the CM/ECF (“Case Management/Electronic Case Files”) system implemented

by the District of Hawaii. *See* Amended General Order Adopting Electronic Case Filing Procedures filed on February 1, 2006.

CJA Panel Attorneys and Mentorship Program Participants shall read and comply with the [United States District Court for the District of Hawaii CJA Plan](#) and [CJA Billing Guide](#), both of which are available on the Court's website at www.hid.uscourts.gov under Court Resources/CJA/CJA Plan and CJA Billing Guide.

CJA Panel Attorneys and Mentorship Program Participants shall also read and otherwise comply with the policies applicable to non-capital representations for counsel appointed under the [Criminal Justice Act](#), 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, set out in the [Criminal Justice Act Policies and Procedures](#) adopted by the Ninth Circuit Judicial Council on October 20, 2016 and amended on January 10, 2020, and which is available on the Court's website at www.hid.uscourts.gov under Court Resources/Ninth Circuit Criminal Justice Act Policies and Procedures.
